Students may wear PE gear only on days they are timetabled for Physical Education class. All other students may order the tracksuit bottoms and t-shirts from this website or wear a plain black or navy tracksuit bottoms and a plain t-shirt. Students may wear runners on the day they have PE.

School Policies & Code of Good Behaviour

School Attendance – Absence, Lateness & Sign Out Notes

Students are expected to attend school every day if they are well. If there is an unscheduled school closure, we will text you. Please call if you ever have any doubt. The Absence, Lateness and Sign Out slips in the School Journal are to be presented to the Yearhead and may be required by the National Education Welfare Board.

When signing your child out during the school day, students must first have a note from their parent/guardian and signed permission from their Yearhead. In the interest of Health and Safety a parent/guardian must present at Reception when signing out a student. Students

who fall ill during the school day and need to contact home should go to their Year Head/Reception in the first instance.
